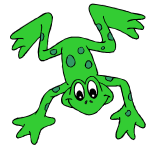

From next Monday we will once again be taking part in the 'virtual round the world bike race' as part of our ongoing 'Bike It' program. Pupils (and parents too) will 'earn' road miles for Hazlehurst Primary's journey along the route for each day that they cycle into school. Every day cycled for the four weeks starting on Monday 1 March and ending Friday 26 March will count towards our final distance.

For pupils who manage to cycle on several days during the four week period, there are some Bike It sheriff badges up for grabs. Pupils who cycle on four days during the four weeks will earn themselves a silver sheriff badge, and those who manage ten days will earn the gold version!

Parents who enjoy cycling are very welcome to get involved too, and the school will earn extra miles for each time a parent cycles with their child. This will really help to bump up our mileage and boost our chances of winning, so let's get pedalling!
