This term your child's study will include the following: -

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<p><u>Going for Goals!</u> Learning about new challenges and setting targets for the future. Not giving up and trying ones best.</p> <p><u>Good to be me.</u> Understanding about feelings and how to express ones self appropriately; thinking of others.</p>
Communication, language and literacy	<p>Revising all letters and sounds already learnt. Learning a range of new sounds. Listening to sounds and writing the correct letter. Blending sounds to read and write words and sentences. Listening to people speaking and taking turns at talking. Joining in appropriately.</p>
Mathematical Development	<p>Recognising, counting, comparing and ordering numbers up to 20. Beginning to learn the basic concepts and language of addition and subtraction. Names of 2-D and 3-D shapes. Comparing length, weight, mass and time. Looking at different coins and labelling. Days of the Week. Patterns.</p>
Creative Development (Art, Music, Dance)	<p>Using all our artistic skills to explore, create and make models focusing on our topics covered this term. Music lessons will be focusing on Patterns and the Working World. P.E. lessons will focus on Games.</p>

Physical Development (P.E., Design, Outdoor play)	<p>Also in P.E. we will be practising throwing, catching sending and receiving using different apparatus. The children will be doing a lot of cooking after half term, learning how to use different kitchen equipment. We will also be taking a trip on a bus to Ramsbottom to do some shopping in connection with our topics.</p>
