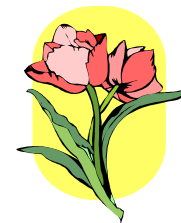

## Curriculum Newsletter

Spring Term 2012



Year 1

This term your child's study will include the following: -

<b>ENGLISH</b>	In Literacy we will be looking at traditional stories and poems with predictable and patterned language (including action rhymes). Our non-fiction work will be focussing on information books including non-chronological reports. We will continue encouraging the use of full stops and capital letters. We will continue to use our knowledge of phonics within our writing and practise the correct formation of all letters.
<b>MATHS</b>	In Maths we will continue to practise addition and subtraction using maths language i.e. less than, take away, subtract/plus, add, more than etc. We will continue to count, recognise and write numbers up to 100. We will begin to work on number facts, place value and counting in 10s from any number. In weight, we will be comparing the weight of objects, focussing on heavier, lighter, same as, & balances. In our shape work we will continue looking at 2D shape, this term focussing on irregular shapes, curved sides, corners & introducing the Hexagon. Data Handling will focus on organising data using simple graphs.
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Our science topics this term are 'Pushes & Pulls' and 'Sorting & Using Materials'. In 'Pushes & Pulls' we will be looking at things that move, pushing and pulling objects, stopping objects and what causes movement. In 'Sorting & Using Materials' we will be handling, describing, grouping & identifying various materials.

<b>HUMANITIE</b>	In <u>R.E</u> we will be looking at Ideas about God in Christianity, Stories Jesus told and finally Easter. In <u>History</u> we will be looking at 'What homes were like long ago'. In <u>Music</u> we will be exploring pulse, rhythm & pitch!
