b) ICT – ‘THE LEARNING PLATFORM’

Q: What IS a Learning Platform?

A: In basic terms, it is your child’s very own webpage. It will give you a personalised view of information and resources relevant to you and your child/children.

The following list gives examples of the kind of information available from the Learning Platform:

- Your child/children’s e-portfolio of their best work done right here in school e.g. videos, photos, audio recording, Microsoft Word documents, flipchart presentations (like PowerPoint), digital produced pictures, etc.
- News that is relevant specifically to your child/children and their key stage.
- On occasions, Years 5 & 6 will send in homework and assignments via this webpage.
- Pupils in Years 5 & 6 have their own e-mail address to send secure e-mails to other children within school, and out of school hours.
- A notice board – containing general school news, useful web links, school events calendar, and useful documents.

To access the portal, enter the following address into your browser: www.klp.rm.com or even easier than that is to follow the ‘Learning Platform’ link on the school website.

To log onto their own portal (web page), your child/children will need to enter their own unique **username** (this is made up of their initial, their surname, and in some cases a number. For example; **p.johnson3**) and **password** (known only to you and your child).

The children have already used this Learning Platform within school and have been given their usernames and passwords. They have been given a card containing this information for use at home.

This portal/webpage has completed its trial in Year 6 last year, and proved to be incredibly successful. Our pupils thoroughly enjoy using this very exciting way of showing what they can achieve and what goes on in class.
